However, behind the wheel, Liam sneered, "Does a five-star restaurant automatically mean it's good quality? Your taste is questionable."




After that, Doyle pressed on the accelerator, and the Bentley swiftly exited the community, leaving Yesenia's family feeling utterly disheartened.
